
The Nicene Creed

through him all things were made.**




**For us and for our salvation




The Prayer of Humble Access





All baptized Christians are welcome and encouraged to take Communion. If you are not baptized and are interested in being baptized, let us know.


If you do not wish to receive Communion, we invite you to come forward, cross your arms, and receive a blessing.

Gluten-free wafers are available upon request.



The Celebrant offers a sentence of Scripture from the day's readings, as a reminder that what we have received from the table is the same reality we received from the Word.




