
## **Collect for Purity**


# The Nicene Creed

through him all things were made.**




**For us and for our salvation



Come to me all of you who are tired of carrying your heavy loads, and I will give you rest. *(Matthew 11.28)*




So, all of you who repent of your sins, who love your neighbors and intend to lead a new life, following the way of Jesus, come with faith and take this holy sacrament to strengthen you.

**Amen. His body was broken for us.**





*All baptized Christians are welcome and encouraged to take Communion. If you are not baptized and are interested in being baptized, let us know.*


